



Beechcraft

The 40 million dollar worth Beechcraft 200 HISAR (Hughes Integrated Surveillance and Reconnaissance System) surveillance aircraft, equipped with a Hughes synthetic aperture radar system by the manufacturer Raytheon. It can track low flying aircraft in addition to ground and sea targets. At the end of 2000 the Sri Lankan government ordered a Raytheon Beechcraft 200 HISAR to further enhance operations against the Tamil Tigers.



Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV)

Surveillance air craft. Cost around each US \$ 1,000,000.



Bell 212 Helicopter

A twin engine version of the Bell series was inducted to the SLAF in 1984 and can carry 13 persons on board and can be used as a gunship as well. Cost US \$ 550,000



K-8 Advanced Jet trainer

Trainer jet. Cost around US \$ 3500,000

Combat gunship. Cost US \$ 5,000,000



PT - 6 Trainer

Trainer jet. Cost around US \$ 350,000



MI-17 troops carrier helicopter

Used to airlift combat troops as well as VIPs. Cost around US \$ 5,000,000.
