(3) Where the Central Authority refuses to execute a request made to him under this Act he shall forthwith inform the appropriate authority of the specified country making the request, the reasons for the refusal.

(2) Where the Central Authority receives, from the appropriate authority in a specified country, in response to a request made by him under subsection (1) —

- (a) any evidence taken in such specified country ; and
- (b) a certificate certifying the taking of such evidence, or the performance of a judicial act, in such specified country,

the Central Authority shall cause such evidence and certificate to be sent to the court or tribunal in which the proceeding to which the request relates is pending, and such evidence and certificate shall be admissible in such proceeding and the statements made in such certificate shall be deemed to be correct unless the contrary is proved.

PART IV

MISCELLANEOUS

12. (1) A request for the service of summons or other document or a request for the taking of evidence or the performance of any other judicial act shall be in one of the official languages of Sri Lanka or in the English language.

Language of request.

(2) Any document accompanying such a request in a language other than English shall have a translation thereof in English, which shall be certified as correct, either by a diplomatic officer or consular agent or by a sworn translator or by any other person duly authorised in Sri Lanka or the specified country.

Refusal of requests.

13. (1) The Central Authority shall refuse to execute a request made to him under Part II or Part III of this Act, if he considers that the execution of the request will be prejudicial to the sovereignty or security of Sri Lanka.

(2) The Central Authority shall refuse to execute a request made to him under Part III of this Act if he considers that the execution of the request does not fall within the functions of the judiciary.

Provisions of this Act, to be in addition to other law providing for service of summons &c.

14. The provisions of this Act shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, the provisions of any other law, enabling the service in Sri Lanka, of any summons or other document issued by a court outside Sri Lanka in relation to a civil or commercial matter, or enabling the taking of evidence in Sri Lanka or the performance of any other judicial act in Sri Lanka, for the purposes of a proceeding in relation to a civil or commercial matter arising outside Sri Lanka.

Sinhala text to prevail in case of inconsistency.

15. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail.

Interpretation.

16. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Country” shall be deemed to include the Hong Kong Administrative region of the People’s Republic of China;

“Judicial act” does not include the issue of a writ or other process for the enforcement or execution of an order or judgment or an order for provisional or protective measures.





PERSONALLY came and appeared before me, the undersigned Notary, the within named Mark Potkewitz and makes this his statement and General Affidavit upon oath and affirmation of belief and personal knowledge that the following matters, facts and things set forth are true and correct to the best of his knowledge:


1. I am age 27. I am of sound mind.
2. On September 24, 2011, on behalf of the plaintiffs, with the aid of two friends, I attempted to serve the complaint and summons in the above captioned case on the Defendant at the New York Buddhist Vihara at 214-22 Spencer Avenue, Queens Village, NY 11427-1821.
3. Mr. Dier, one of my friends, and I entered the temple at approximately 9:51 AM, EST, where we were interrogated as to the purpose of our visit. We were told that it was a "special day" for the temple because they were expecting an important guest.

4. After answering more questions and denying we were journalists, we were asked to show our state driver's licenses, and were granted entry and permission to take photographs of the interior.
5. Mr. Dier and I wandered the temple for around 20 minutes while taking photographs and chatting with the monks about Mahayana and Theravada Buddhism. After taking some literature on Buddhism and the temple's services, we asked if we could sit in on the service and were granted permission.
6. At approximately 10:12 AM, Mr. Dier and I were approached by a representative of the temple and told to leave because of the imminent arrival of the Sri Lankan president, ie, the Defendant. After asking to meet the President, or, at the very least, to have our photographs taken with him.
7. Mr. Dier and I were asked again to leave the temple and escorted out of the temple and witnessed the arrival of a Sri Lankan official Town Car with diplomatic license plates. Mr. Dier and I remained outside the temple on the sidewalk in an attempt to stall until the Defendant exited the Town Car. Bodyguards, both with visible earpieces and concealed wrist microphones remained between us and the Town Car.
8. The Defendant VIP was not allowed to leave the Town Car until Mr. Dier and I left the area. To ensure our departure, two bodyguards followed us around the street corner and down the block until we both rounded a corner of a commercial street.

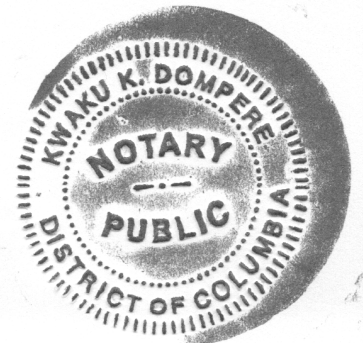

**ORDER**

(October 13, 2011)

On October 1, 2011, Plaintiffs filed [6] Motion for Service by Publication or Alternative Means. Having unsuccessfully served Defendant with process via the Hague Convention, mail, and in person, Plaintiffs now seek to serve Defendant with process by one of a number of means, including publication, Twitter, Facebook, and email.

Having evaded service in person and refusing service under the international agreement established for the purpose of service of process on international defendants, “it is not reasonably possible or practicable to give more adequate warning” to Defendant than service by publication. *Mullane v. Central Hanover Bank & Trust Co.*, 339 U.S. 306, 317 (1950). Assuming that Defendant does not already have actual notice of the action based on Plaintiffs’ attempts to serve process under the Hague Convention, publication in newspapers of general circulation six days per week for four weeks is reasonably calculated to apprise Defendant of the lawsuit and afford him an opportunity to object.

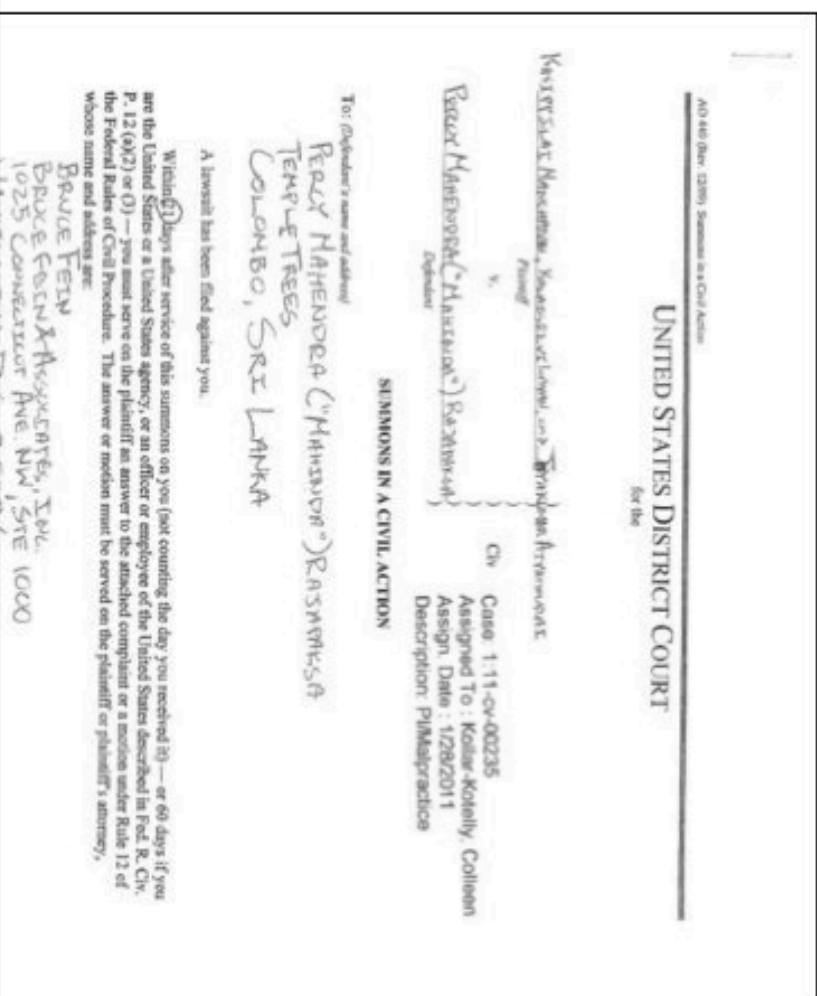

Here is our yearend summary of media conditions in Sri Lanka. It was updated recently, though it might be revised (sadly, for the worse) before it goes online.

[The government's effort to silence critical media](#) has been brutally effective as politically motivated deaths, attacks, and disappearances go uninvestigated and unprosecuted. The websites *Groundviews* and its sister Sinhala and Tamil site *Vikalpa* became the last independent online news presence based in Sri Lanka, following a series of attacks on the website *Lanka eNews*. After arsonists attacked the offices of *Lanka eNews* in January, authorities arrested the site's Colombo-based news editor [Bennet Rupasinghe](#) in March and was held for several days in police custody for allegedly threatening a brother of a suspect over the arson attack before being released on bail. Published from London, the site was [temporarily banned in April](#) and was [no longer available in October](#). Authorities have turned the notion of law enforcement on its head, obstructing justice in numerous attacks against journalists. Prime examples are the unsolved 2010 disappearance of cartoonist [Prageeth Eknelygoda](#), and the unsolved 2009 murder of [prominent editor Lasantha Wickramatunga](#). But those cases are hardly unusual. President Mahinda Rajapaksa has presided over an appalling era in which every journalist murder—nine since he rose to high office—has gone unpunished. Anti-press violence continued in 2011. In July [Gnanasundaram Kuhanathan](#), news editor of the Tamil-language daily *Uthayan*, was assaulted in northern Sri Lanka by assailants wielding iron bars. There have been no arrests in the case. Media access to the northern, predominantly Tamil areas of the country remains restricted for local and international media. The government rejected allegations that its armed forces and paramilitary groups violated international humanitarian law during the last phase of the war, saying there were no civilian deaths. Not have the secessionist Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam admitted that they committed any war crimes.

## In Sri Lanka, anti-government website blocked

New York, October 19, 2011--The Committee to Protect Journalists is alarmed by reports that access to anti-government news website *Lanka eNews* has been blocked inside Sri Lanka, according to the site's exiled editor and users inside the country. All three language versions of the site, [English \(http://www.lankaenews.com/English/\)](http://www.lankaenews.com/English/), [Sinhala \(http://www.lankaenews.com/Sinhala/\)](http://www.lankaenews.com/Sinhala/), and [Tamil \(http://www.lankaenews.com/tamil/\)](http://www.lankaenews.com/tamil/), have not been available since Tuesday.

A Sri Lankan journalist told CPJ by email today that the shutdown could have stemmed from *Lanka eNews*' October 15 [coverage \(http://www.lankaenews.com/English/news.php?id=12350SafariHTML%5CShell%5COpen%5CCommand\)](http://www.lankaenews.com/English/news.php?id=12350SafariHTML%5CShell%5COpen%5CCommand) of a shootout involving parliamentarians close to Defense Secretary Gothabaya Rajapaksa, brother of President Mahinda Rajapaksa. In Colombo on Saturday, a presidential aide and his bodyguard were shot dead in a fight involving opposing factions of the Sri Lankan ruling party during local elections, news reports [said \(http://english.cri.cn/6966/2011/10/10/2821s662067.htm\)](http://english.cri.cn/6966/2011/10/10/2821s662067.htm). Other Sri Lankan media either ignored the story or played it [down \(http://www.srilankaguardian.org/2011/10/after-local-government-elections.html\)](http://www.srilankaguardian.org/2011/10/after-local-government-elections.html). The government denies being behind the shutdown, *Lanka eNews* said.

Virtually all of the reporting for the site is now generated from outside the country. In March 2010, *Lanka eNews*' founder and editor Sandaruwan Senadheera went into [exile \(/2011/01/united-nations-must-intervene-to-protect-sri-lanka.php\)](/2011/01/united-nations-must-intervene-to-protect-sri-lanka.php) in England after repeatedly receiving death threats.

"The blocking of access to *Lanka eNews* inside Sri Lanka is the next step in the government's move toward silencing this adamantly anti-establishment website," said Bob Dietz, CPJ's Asia program coordinator. "*Lanka eNews* is one of the country's few independent news sources left uncowed. This is another effort by the Rajapaksa government to stifle independent media criticism. The government must back away from this policy and allow the country's once-flourishing media to resume their proper role."

In June, access to independent news and analysis website [Groundviews \(http://groundviews.org/\)](http://groundviews.org/) and its Sinhala version, [Vikalpa \(http://vikalpa.org/\)](http://vikalpa.org/), were temporarily blocked, CPJ research shows. *Groundviews* founder Sanjana Hattotuwa [told CPJ \(/blog/2011/06/sri-lankas-groundviews-is-back-online-after-sudden.php\)](/blog/2011/06/sri-lankas-groundviews-is-back-online-after-sudden.php) at the time that the shutdown was no mistake and it could have been a signal to them to shut up. [Transparency International \(http://www.transparency.org/\)](http://www.transparency.org/), often critical of corruption within the Sri Lankan government, was also blocked temporarily at the time.

*Lanka eNews* has been targeted many times in recent years. In [April \(/2011/04/another-lanka-enews-journalist-arrested.php\)](/2011/04/another-lanka-enews-journalist-arrested.php), the site's staff members were arrested then released weeks later, and in the same month, the site was temporarily [banned \(/2011/04/sri-lankan-authorities-ban-lanka-enews.php\)](/2011/04/sri-lankan-authorities-ban-lanka-enews.php) by a court order. In [January \(/2011/01/united-nations-must-intervene-to-protect-sri-lanka.php\)](/2011/01/united-nations-must-intervene-to-protect-sri-lanka.php), the offices were hit with an arson attack. The

## Sri Lankan government blocks websites

New York, November 7, 2011--The Committee to Protect Journalists is deeply concerned by reports that access to at least five Sri Lankan websites has been blocked by the country's government.

The sites were blocked because they had maligned top government officials, the secretary of the media ministry told the [BBC](http://www.bbc.co.uk/news/world-asia-15621160). A Sri Lankan official said, "A number of websites have already been blocked because they have engaged in 'character assassination' of the president [Mahinda Rajapaksa]," the BBC reported.

The BBC reported a government official saying that any website dealing with Sri Lankan affairs must register with the government or face legal action. Although newspapers, radio, and television stations must already register with the government before they start publishing, such requirements are new for websites, The Associated Press [reported](http://www.washingtonpost.com/world/asia-pacific/sri-lanka-says-it-blocked-5-news-websites-because-they-insulted-key-political-leaders/2011/11/07/gIQAy2yduM_story.html).

"Blocking online media is another step in the Sri Lankan government's plan to silence any media critical of its policies or personnel," said Bob Dietz, CPJ's Asia program coordinator. "The government must stop targeting news media and allow them to resume reporting."

The blocked websites include [Lanka eNews](http://www.lankaenews.com/), [Sri Lanka Mirror](http://www.srilankamirror.com/english/), [Sri Lanka Guardian](http://www.srilankaguardian.org/), and [Lanka Way News](http://www.lankawaynews.com/), according to Anusha Palpita, the director general of the Telecommunication Regulatory Commission, the AP reported.

Lanka eNews, a staunchly anti-government website, has been under [attack](#) for more than two years. In [April](#), the site's staff members were arrested then released weeks later, and in the same month, the site was temporarily [banned](#) by a court order. In [January](#), the offices were hit with an arson attack. The site's political cartoonist, [Prageeth Eknelygoda](#), has been missing since January 2010.

“Neither President Rajapakse nor I on his behalf will answer questions on war crimes, Director of the Presidential Media Unit told Lanka Standard today. The defiance from the Presidential Secretariat came

when Lanka Standard asked the President’s spokesperson how the President reacts to the new order by the US District Court on alternative service of summons.

Slammed by litigation and police investigation into war crimes Sri Lanka’s beleaguered President is running scared. In New York’s Buddhist Vihara this September, the 65 year old Rajapakse refused to alight from his vehicle until two agents, there to serve summons on him in the Manoharan case filed in the US District Court of Washington DC, had been safely escorted out of the premises and the vicinity by his body guards.

Now, due to leave to the Commonwealth Heads of Government meeting later this month Rajapakse has more on his plate. The International Commission of Jurists, Australia has passed on a dossier of war crimes to the Australian

Federal Police. The Federal Police we learn is now studying this dossier even as the Australian government is pressurized to take action against Sri Lanka. For H.E. Mahinda Rajapakse, life is getting uncomfortable – if not at home then at least when he travels abroad. Something we know the Rajapakses love to do. After all that is a part of the charm of being all powerful.

In the meantime the US Courts last week granted Plaintiffs Manoharan et al their motion to serve summons on Sri Lanka President Mahinda Rajapakse by publication or alternative means. In granting Plaintiff's motion filed October 1, judge Colleen Kollar-Kotelly said the Plaintiffs were authorised to complete service upon defendant Rajapakse in his personal capacity by publishing in two Sri Lankan newspapers with the largest circulation and on the main page of the Tamilnet website."

On calling the Presidential media unit and asking to be directed to Rajapakse's media spokesperson this correspondent was directed to Mr. Lucien Rajakarunanayake.

On being asked whether the government or President Rajapakse will take action against any local newspapers that published the summons and the full 29 page complaint, Rajakarunanayake refused to answer any questions saying all allegations were baseless.

"In US none of the journalists are even allowed to talk to Obama and that is their democracy. But here anyone can talk to President Mahinda Rajapakse but he will not answer and is not answerable to these allegations. These summons have been published in pro LTTE websites. There are certain protocols to be followed. Speak to our Ambassador in Washington ," he said.

### **Rajapakse pleads the fifth**

"Neither President Rajapakse nor I on his behalf will answer any questions on this matter," he further said.

The Plaintiffs in the said case are seeking damages in excess of \$30 million against President Rajapakse for actions allegedly occurring under his command responsibility as Head of State and Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces.

The complaint alleges that President Rajapakse held command responsibility for the extrajudicial killings of Ragihar Manoharan, the son of Plaintiff Dr. Kasippillai Manoharan, Premas Anandarajah, a humanitarian aid worker for Action Against Hunger, and first husband of Plaintiff Kalaiselvi Lavan, and four members of the Tevarajah family, all relatives of Plaintiff Jeyakumar Aiyathurai.
