

Chapter 3 Human cost of High Security Zones (HSZ)

A much ignored sociological phenomenon in the NorthEast is the flow on effects of the declaration of the HSZs. In the first instance, the reader must ask herself what type of meaning she is attaching to the phrase "High Security Zone". If one reviews the usage of this phrase in other countries, the very limited application of this phrase will become very evident. The phrase is in fact used to delineate very sensitive regions such as the parliament, a state's leader's official residence, and regions of high military secrecy that are located far away from civilian areas for obvious reasons. In the NorthEast as will be seen below the application of this phrase has entirely different meaning.

The HSZ phenomenon in the NorthEast started in the early 1980's and has gradually expanded and evolved into what is today. This document provides statistics on HSZ in the NorthEast of the island which will show how the meaning of this phrase as used in the NorthEast has an entirely different meaning to its international usage. Not many people today will be aware that even as late as the 1970's, Palaly airport, the only airport in the northern Sri Lanka that was a civilian international airport, was providing flights to Colombo and to India. Today, it is one of the most militarized areas in the island situated within one of the largest HSZ in the island. The largest number of HSZ instigated displacement of civilians is from this Palaly HSZ. The plight of the displaced languishing in refugee camps for more than 15 years resulting in the deterioration of their culture is a story that still remains to be told.

The displacement of civilians in the Trincomalee district started even earlier in the 1980s. Many of these civilians have been living in the Mullaitivu district in refugee camps for more than 20 years.

For all the HSZ refugees the loss of their land has far reaching implications. The material content involved in the loss of one's home itself is a devastating matter. For most people their life's earnings is deposited into building their home. Many people have lost it due the HSZ. The loss of land and the community for people amounts to the destruction of a way of life and culture that is irreplaceable. The land is the source of livelihood for most people and they have lost this land. The statistics below gives some idea of the agricultural land lost. Besides this most people have coconut trees, fruit trees, and other trees that sustain the nutritional needs of the people. Living in refugee camps all of this is lost. The denial of fishing rights and barb wiring more than 100 Km of coastline from the fishermen is yet another dimension to this HSZ implication to the people.

The violation of children's rights caused by the HSZ displacement is yet another dimension that has not been addressed. As the statistics show at least 68 schools have been denied their buildings by the HSZ. One can go on stating the child rights violations caused by the HSZ. These are best explained in the United Nation High Commission on Human Rights Fact Sheet 25 on "Forced Evictions".

To drive the point raised at the start regarding the usage of the phrase HSZ, a search on the Internet was made for this phrase. The results are attached in Annexure-2. First seven entries returned by Google are about the HSZ in the NorthEast. This proves the point that GoSL has redefined the meaning of the term HSZ.







Military occupation out of HSZs in Jaffna district


